4. Estimated cost of item(s) and an explanation why the amount to be expended is considered reasonable:

Estimated Cost: \$10,757.81 (discount applied; shipping and handling included; no tax)

Reasonableness of Cost:

Pricing is directly from LEGO Education and includes a promotional discount of \$448.24.

LEGO Education products are specialized for educational use, combining durable materials with standards-based curricula.

The pricing is competitive compared to the educational value and longevity of use across multiple years and programs.

5. Explanation of the efforts taken by the department to determine this is the only source and the efforts used to obtain the best possible price:

The department confirmed through direct communication with LEGO Education and the provided Sole Source Letter that LEGO Education is the only authorized distributor for these educational products.

The department worked with LEGO Education to secure a promotional discount (Promo Code XSPLAIAY2J) to ensure the most favorable pricing.

No other vendors are authorized to provide the full LEGO Education sets, associated curriculum, and necessary support services required for the Imaginarium's programming.

If after a review of the submitted notice and documents, MSU determines that the commodity in the proposed sole source request can be provided by another person or entity, then MSU will withdraw the sole source request publication from the procurement portal website and submit the procurement of the commodity to an advertised competitive bid or selection process.

If MSU determines after review that there is only one (1) source for the required commodity, then MSU will appeal to the Public Procurement Review Board. MSU will have the burden of proving that the commodity is only provided by one (1) source.
