Notice of Proposed Sole Source Purchase

Mississippi State University anticipates purchasing the item(s) listed below as a sole source purchase. Anyone objecting to this purchase shall follow the procedures outlined below.

1. Commodity or commodities to be purchased (make, model, description):

Support & Maintenance for ARMS Enterprise, Arms Mobile, Arms v3 CAD, Arms Nibrs, Public Mapping Portal Maxient Submitter.

2. Explanation of the need to be fulfilled by this item(s), how is it unique from all other options, and why it is the only one that can meet the specific needs of the department:

A closely guarded process for database design and construction is also utilized which is unique to the ARMS Enterprise system. No product on the market utilizes the same innovative design or the functionality that the design allows in the product.

3. Name of company/individual selling the item and why that source is the only possible source that can provide the required item(s):

End2End Public Safety -

There are no other like item(s) or product(s) available for purchase that would serve the same purpose or functions.

4. Estimated cost of item(s) and an explanation why the amount to be expended is considered reasonable:

\$12,249.80

There is only one price because of exclusive distribution or marketing rights.

5. Explanation of the efforts taken by the department to determine this is the only source and the efforts used to obtain the best possible price:

We have been using End2End Public Safety for several years. There is no other source that is compatible with the system we are using.

Subject Line must read "Sole Source Objection"

The notice shall contain a detailed explanation of why the commodity is not a sole source procurement. Appropriate documentation shall also be submitted if applicable.

If after a review of the submitted notice and documents, MSU determines that the commodity in the proposed sole source request can be provided by another person or entity, then MSU will withdraw the sole source request publication from the procurement portal website and submit the procurement of the commodity to an advertised competitive bid or selection process.

If MSU determines after review that there is only one (1) source for the required commodity, then MSU will appeal to the Public Procurement Review Board. MSU will have the burden of proving that the commodity is only provided by one (1) source.

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
